The Electors and Citizens qualified to vote in Town meetings of the Town of Thompson, Connecticut, are hereby notified and warned that a Town Meeting of said Town will be held at the Seney Community Room at Thompson Town Hall, 815 Riverside Drive, North Grosvenordale, Connecticut, on Wednesday, July 17, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. for the following purposes:

1. To choose a moderator for said meeting.
J. Rice made a motion to and A. Witkowski seconded to nominate F. McGarry as moderator. Rene Morin made a motion and A. Witkowski seconded to close nominations. Both Motions passed.

2. To consider and act upon the following resolution:
RESOLVED, that the Town appropriate up to Five Hundred Fifty-Thousand Dollars (\$550,000) from the Town Fund Balance for school building and facility security improvements of which an estimated 68.57% is to be refundable through the school construction grant program. The reimbursed amount would then be returned to the Fund Balance.

Motion by J. Rice and seconded by A. Witkowski to approve item #2. Discussion followed.


District No. 1 — Thompson Hill Fire Department, 70 Chase Road, Thompson
