The Electors and Citizens qualified to vote in Town meetings of the Town of Thompson, Connecticut, are hereby notified and warned that the Annual Town Meeting of said Town will be held at the Thompson Public Library/Louis P. Faucher Community Center, 934 Riverside Drive, North Grosvenordale, Connecticut, on Monday, May 2, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. for the following purposes:

1. To choose a moderator for said meeting;
Motion by Geoffrey Bolte and seconded by Diane Jamieson to nominate Francis McGarry as moderator.
Motion that nominations be closed made by Geoffrey Bolte and seconded by H. Charles Obert.
Motion Passes.
Motion to elect Francis McGarry as moderator passes.
2. To consider and act upon recommendations of the Board of Finance that appropriations be made for the fiscal year budget for the period beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023 in the amount of \$28,468,767.00 and to make such appropriations as are advisable in adopting a Town budget.
Motion by Jessica Bolte and seconded by Kathleen Herbert to approve article #2. Motion passes.

3. To consider and act upon the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Selectmen, acting as agents for the Town of Thompson, be authorized to apply for and receive any state or federal grants that may become available and appear to them to be in the best interest of the Town of Thompson.

Motion by H. Charles Obert and seconded by Geoffrey Bolte to approve article #3. Motion passes.

4. To consider and act upon the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the Town of Thompson's local capital improvement projects of \$85,574.00 and capital improvement plan as defined in Section 7-535 through 7-538, a copy of which plan is on file in the Office of the Board of Selectmen and available for public inspection during normal business hours, is hereby ratified and approved.

Motion by Jessica Bolte and seconded by Heather Santos to approve article #4. Motion passes.

5. Notice is further given, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-7 of the Connecticut General Statutes; and the Town budget resolution presented at the Town Meeting on September 29, 1997 and approved at referendum on October 9, 1997, the Board of Selectmen has removed Item 2 (approval of the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 budget) for submission to voters to vote upon paper ballots on Monday, May 16, 2022 between the hours of 12:00 p.m. (noon) and 8:00 p.m. at the following regular polling places:

District No. 1 — Thompson Library/Community Center, 934 Riverside Drive, North Grosvenordale

District No. 2 — Town Office Building, 815 Riverside Drive, North Grosvenordale


District No. 3 — Quinebaug Fire Department, 720 Quinebaug Road, Quinebaug

District No. 4 — East Thompson Fire Department, 530 East Thompson Road, Thompson

Persons qualified to vote in Town meetings who are not electors will vote at the Town Office Building, 815 Riverside Drive, North Grosvenordale. Absentee ballots will be available from the Town Clerk's office at Town Hall. Absentee ballots will be counted at the following central location: Conference Room, Second Floor, Town Office Building, 815 Riverside Drive, North Grosvenordale. Action on said items at the Town Meeting will be limited to reasonable discussion only.
