NOTICE OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING – March 16, 2022

The Electors and Citizens qualified to vote in Town meetings of the Town of Thompson, Connecticut, are hereby notified and warned that a Special Town Meeting of said Town will be held at the Thompson Public Library/Louis P. Faucher Community Center, 934 Riverside Drive, North Grosvenordale, Connecticut, on Wednesday, March 16, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. in the evening.

The purposed of the meeting will be:

1. To choose a moderator for the meeting. John Rice made motion to nominate Francis McGarry as moderator and the motion was seconded by Mary Eames. Motion nominations be closed made by John Rice and seconded by John Lenky. Motion passes. First motion passes.
2. To consider and act upon the following resolution:
To adopt amended ordinance NO. 10-049, VOTING DISTRICTS

Proposed Ordinance 10-049 Revision for 3-16-2022 Town Meeting The ordinance regarding Voting Districts as initially adopted August 1, 1937, and further amended on October 3, 1960, and May 19, 1981, is hereby amended and restated as follows: BE IT ENACTED, by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened: Section 1: The Selectmen of the Town of Thompson are authorized and directed to establish three (3) voting districts therein and fix boundaries thereof. Section 2: The three voting districts shall be known as Voting District 3, Voting District 4 and Voting District 5, and are depicted on a map entitled “Town of Thompson, CT Voting Districts,” dated March 16, 2022, and incorporated herein as the official map of the voting districts of the Town of Thompson. Section 3: Each elector of said town shall vote in the district in which he resides. Section 4: The registrars of voters of said town shall prepare a list of the electors in each voting district, giving the name of each such elector and his residence by street and number if possible. Section 5: Any elector who shall move his residence from one voting district in said town to another voting district therein shall notify the registrars of voters of such removal, giving the street and number from which he moved, the street and number of his new residence and the date of such removal, and may vote in the district from which he moved at any time within fifteen (15) days thereafter.

Motion made by Stephen Herbert and seconded by Randolph Blackmer to adopt the amended ordinance as proposed.

William Warner moved to amend the question as follows:

Amend Section 1: to substitute the phrase “four (4)” for the phrase “three (3)” and,

amend Section 2: to change the word “three” to “four” and substitute the phrase “Voting District 1, Voting District 2, Voting District 3 and Voting District 4” for the phrase “Voting District 3, Voting District 4 and Voting District 5,” and,

amend Section 2: to and substitute the proposed map with the map entitled “Town of Thompson, CT Voting Districts, dated March 17.

Motion seconded by Jane Salce.
