- I. Community Kitchens- Dave Dunham
  - A. Discussed program of serving meals to residents since 1982. Thompson has donated \$1,000, which averages \$20 per week.
  - B. Learned that North Grosvenordale site closed end of 2014 and moved to Woodstock church on the Green for Fiscal Year 2015.
  - C. Questions asked if Woodstock donated to fund and how many people from Thompson went to Woodstock.
  - D. Dunham would attempt to get these answers for the BOS.
- II. NDDH- Susan Starkey
  - A. Presented program and services to BOS.
  - B. Contribution to Health Dist will increase from \$4.20 to \$4.41. There has been no increase in the past few years. Based on the Thompson population of 9,308 residents, the increase will be \$1,045.
- III. United Services- Ande Bloom
  - A. Discussed EAP program to employees. No current contract- no budget for 15/16. \$30 per employees charge for 65 employees. Total cost \$1,950. Will check with other Town policies in case of possible other coverage.
  - B. United Youth did not present. There is a contribution in the past budget for \$6,215.
- IV. NECCOG- John Filchak
  - A. Presented scope of services Town may enter into and where it participates currently.
  - B. Assessment of .95 per capita. Based on 9308 total \$8,843. Reval \$30,747.60. Transit dist 7,769. Paramedic program 89.10 per call average 190 estimate \$16,929.
- V. Probate Court- Leah Schad
  - A. 9308 at 1.17 per capita.
