NOTICE OF ANNUAL TOWN MEETING – May 1, 2023
NOTICE OF REFERENDUM – May 15, 2023

The Electors and Citizens qualified to vote in Town meetings of the Town of Thompson, Connecticut, are hereby notified and warned that the Annual Town Meeting of said Town will be held at the Thompson Public Library/Louis P. Faucher Community Center, 934 Riverside Drive, North Grosvenordale, Connecticut, on Monday, May 1, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. for the following purposes:

1. To choose a moderator for said meeting;
2. To consider and act upon recommendations of the Board of Finance that appropriations be made for the fiscal year budget for the period beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024 in the amount of \$30,752,118 and to make such appropriations as are advisable in adopting a Town budget.
3. To consider and act upon the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the Town of Thompson enter into a contract for Resident State Trooper Services for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 as included in the proposed FY 2023-2024 Budget.

The aforesaid resolution shall be placed on the ballot under the following heading:

“SHALL THE TOWN OF THOMPSON ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR RESIDENT STATE TROOPER SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 AS INCLUDED IN THE PROPOSED FY 2023-2024 BUDGET?”

4. To consider and act upon the following resolutions:

RESOLVED, that the Town of Thompson’s local capital improvement projects of \$86,828 and capital improvement plan as defined in CT State Statutes Section 7-535 through 7-538, a copy of which plan is on file in the Office of the Board of Selectmen and available for public inspection during normal business hours, is hereby ratified and approved.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Selectmen, acting as agents for the Town of Thompson, be authorized to apply for and receive any state or federal grants that may become available and appear to them to be in the best interest of the Town of Thompson.

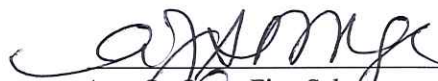
RESOLVED, to adopt the Ordinance concerning Quaddick Lake “Reservoir”

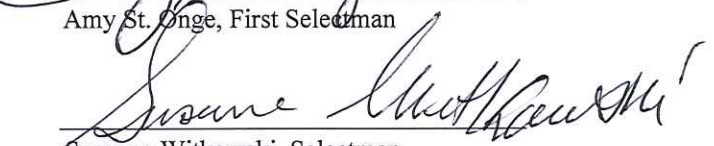

Notice is further given, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-7 of the Connecticut General Statutes; and the Town budget resolution presented at the Town Meeting on September 29, 1997 and approved at referendum on October 9, 1997, the Board of Selectmen has removed Item 2 (approval of the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 budget) for submission to voters to vote upon paper ballots on Monday, May 15, 2023 between the hours of 12:00 p.m. (noon) and 8:00 p.m. at the following regular polling places:

District No. 1 — Thompson Library/Community Center, 934 Riverside Drive, North Grosvenordale
District No. 2 — Town Office Building, 815 Riverside Drive, North Grosvenordale
District No. 3 — Quinebaug Fire Department, 720 Quinebaug Road, Quinebaug
District No. 4 — East Thompson Fire Department, 530 East Thompson Road, Thompson

Persons qualified to vote in Town meetings who are not electors will vote at the Town Office Building, 815 Riverside Drive, North Grosvenordale. Absentee ballots will be available from the Town Clerk’s office at Town Hall. Absentee ballots will be counted at the following central location: Conference Room, Second Floor, Town Office Building, 815 Riverside Drive, North Grosvenordale. Action on said items at the Town Meeting will be limited to reasonable discussion only.
