A) Call to Order & Roll Call:

Meeting was called to order by Chair Peter Ricard at 7:01 PM.

    - 1) WAA15019 Leo Bellanceau, 653 Quaddick Town Farm Rd, Assessor's Map 160, Block 11, Lot 17, removal & replacement of mobile home with minor grading in upland review area, received by Wetlands Office 8/11/15, Ms. Butts stated no change, still awaiting B100a approval from NDDH, no action taken, Ms. Butts was informed by the Thompson Building Office that the mobile home has already been replaced with a new one but no approval from NDDH has been received and apparently no grading was done in the upland review area as proposed. Commissioner Obert stated he thought he saw something on that site, Ms. Butts said she still hasn't had time to do a site visit but will try in next couple weeks.

- F) Active Violations & Pending Enforcement Actions:
  - a) VIOL14002 issued 1/28/14, to Norman Rudzinski, 0 Labby Rd., Assessor's Map 95, Block 27, Lot 17, Violation file remains open until all work referenced under permit IWA14012 is satisfactorily completed. Ms. Butts still hasn't had time to visit the site due to the amount of time spent on #IWA15025 & #IWA15029 public hearings.

- 170 Wilsonville Road (new violation file VIOL16009, previous violation file VIOL14020) after several inquiries Ms. Butts inspected the site on 6/2/16 and found new fill so she issued a new violation.
- 12 School Street On 6/2/16 Ms. Butts noticed grading work and stonewall construction occurring within 100 feet of Phelps Park Pond with no erosion and sediment controls in place.
- **DEC16008**, Todd Pihl, 411 Lowell Davis Rd, on 6/2/16 Ms. Butts signed the request for selective timber harvest in upland review area as long as no cutting occurs in wetlands and no upland review area is clear cut.

Commissioner Obert asked Ms. Butts if it is possible to put underground gas tanks in a flood plain area and she said they would probably require all the electrical to be above the 100year flood elevation and it would be up to FEMA.

Commissioner Tillen stated in the Habitat there is talk about regulating ATV and snowmobile activity and asked Ms. Butts if she has done anything with that and she said no, that's more of a conservation issue unless it is damaging wetlands.
