A) Call to Order & Roll Call:

Meeting was called to order by Chair Morano at 7:14 PM.

G) Other Business:

a) New form for Jurisdictional Rulings – All Commissioners like the new form.

Motion to approve the finalized draft of this new Jurisdictional Rulings Form for use permitted as of right for non-regulated use was made by Commissioner Obert. Seconded by Commissioner Thomas. Motion passed unanimously.

H) Reports:

- a) Budget & Expenditures: Wetlands Budget for Fiscal Year 2016–2017 (Results of Fiscal Reporting 7/1/16 4/27/17) Commissioner Obert stated that the Commission has used 77.6% overall of its budget.
- b) Wetlands Agent Report for March, April and May 2017:
 - VIOL17017 issued 5/8/17 to Linden O'Leary, President of Quaddick Mountain Road Properties, Assessor's Map 143, Block 16, Lots 17, 17AK, 17AL, 17AM & 17AN, Ms. Butts visited the property on 5/5/17 and explained to the Commission why she issued a violation on 5/8/17.

Updates:

- DEEP MS4 General Permit Status & Inspection a meeting between DEEP staff and town staff to discuss Thompson's activities towards meeting the requirements of the MS4 General Permit on 3/20/17. Subsequent to that meeting Ms. Butts and Dennis Blanchette of J&D Civil Engineers worked together to produce a draft Stormwater Management Plan which is posted on the Town's webpage for citizen comments. Ms. Butts has been helping Renee to understand and organize the requirements of the MS4 and SMP so she can redirect her time to Wetlands Office Issues. Ms. Butts explained the Inland Wetlands Commissions responsibility under the SMP.
- DEEP Industrial General Permits Since the Selectman's Office received a DEEP NOV on 12/20/16 Ms. Butts has continued to provide assistance on the Transfer Station and the Public Works Garage. It appears the Public Works Garage may not require a permit registration if the Town can get a certification from a professional engineer licensed to practice in CT that there is no concentrated discharge from the site to waters of the state. Ms. Butts has been inspecting the garage after heavy rains to document runoff conditions and will produce a report to be forwarded to Dennis Blanchette for his information and use.

Inspections/Follow-Up Actions:

- DEC16024 Following inquires by several local residents Ms. Butts visited the site on 4/27/17 and found significant amount of soil being tracked onto the road by logging trucks so she contacted Hull Forest Products and the Church and they have added woodchips to the access road and is sweeping the road. It appears the harvest should be completed soon.
- IWA16018 Ms. Butts visited this site to check on conditions and found fruit trees
 planted and wood fence erected but no fill had been removed per permit so she will
 contact owner to set a deadline for the fill removal.

Wetlands Agent Approvals: WAA17009 approval issued 3/15/17 & WAA17012 approval issued 3/23/17.

Miscellaneous:

- New IWC Member Today Ms. Butts was informed that Diane Chapin was appointed to the IWC by the Selectman at their 5/2/17 meeting, she has not been sworn in yet.
- Memo to P&Z On 2/27/17 Ms. Butts sent a memo to the Thompson Planning & Zoning Commission regarding Johnson, 20 Alex Dr. 143/16/57B, 2-lot re-sub-division, stating it did not contain any wetlands or watercourses.
- Correction on ECCD Donation the IWC already made their \$1K donation in October.
- Westview Elderly Independent Living Housing Project On 4/10/17 Ms. Butts attended a meeting with Mary Ann Chinatti, Ken Beausoleil and reps for the Westview Land Company to discuss a proposed elderly independent living complex located off of Azud Rd & Rte. 12 which will require at least a wetlands agent approval.
- Madison Ave Sub-division On 4/27/17 Ms. Butts sent a memo to the Thompson P&Z Commission regarding the plans compliance with the 2002 Connecticut Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment control and advised a modification to lot 18 driveways grade.

- K) Comments by Commission: A long discussion ensued between the Commissioners regarding several things like the need for a "Hall of Recognition" where they could hang a plaque issued to Nancy N. Kriz that was found in a store room, the Public Notice of the Stormwater Discharge Permit, MS4 & NOV, what the Economic Development Committee's is doing with the project "Rebranding Thompson" and that New England's soil is favorable for land disposal of fracking water and the Conservation Commission feels the town should create a Fracking Ordinance.

Motion to send a letter to Selectman stating this Commission supports a fracking ordinance in Thompson was made by Commissioner Obert. Seconded by Commissioner Thomas. Motion passed unanimously.
