SITE WALK NOTES
INLAND WETLANDS COMMISSION
SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 10, 2018

On Saturday, November 10, 2018 an Inland Wetlands Commission site walk was performed.

The Inland Wetlands Commission site walk began at 9:01 AM in the parking lot located on the west side of East Putnam Road just south of the Thompson / Putnam town line as shown on the map attached to the agenda for the site walk. The purpose of the site walk was to view site conditions associated with the excavation of a 6± acre pond, portions of which are located in the 200-foot upland review area for the especially noteworthy wetlands associated with Five Mile River, Teft Brook and Lower Pond as shown in Application IWA18027. In attendance were Commissioners Obert and O'Neil, Thompson Conservation Officer Carolyn Werge, Thompson Zoning Enforcement Officer Cynthia Dunne, David Held, P.E. of Provost & Rovero for the applicant, Allan Rawson for Northeast Opportunities for Wellness and myself.

The group entered the site through an opening in a wire fence that demarks the southern boundary of the site located near the parking area. Then the group walked northward along an existing pathway towards Wetlands Flag (WF) #27. After viewing the wetlands near WF #27, the group travelled westward along an exiting pathway in the upland review area, briefly stopping to view conditions in and near wetlands at WF #37, WF #43 WF #48 and WF #52. The group then travelled south and then east returning to the parking lot through the opening in the wire fence. During this time the submitted plans were consulted several times with Mr. Held confirming site locations on the plans. The meeting ended at 9:36 AM and the group disbanded independently walking back to their parked vehicles.
