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SITE WALK Notes
INLAND WETLANDS COMMISSION
SATURDAY, April 6, 2019

On Saturday April 6, 2019 the Inland Wetlands Commission was scheduled to perform two site walks: 363 Quaddick Town Farm Road and the Sand Dam Road crossing of the Five Mile River. Given only Commissioner H. Charles Obert was in attendance, no meeting was held. These notes, though not required, are filed for the purpose of documenting the actions taken.

The site walk for 363 Quaddick Town Farm Road began at 9:10 AM in the driveway to the existing residence on the property. The purpose of this portion of the site walk was to view site conditions associated with the excavation of sand and gravel, portions of which are located in the 100-foot upland review area. In attendance were Commissioner H. Charles Obert, Allan Rawson for the owner River Junction Estates, LLC, David Held, P.E. of Provost & Rovero for the applicant, and myself.

Beginning at the driveway to the residence of 363 Quaddick Town Farm Road the group walked to observe the wetlands south of wetlands flag #9, located off site. The group then walked northeast parallel to the flagged wetlands to a test pit west of wetlands flag #23. The wetlands east and south of wetlands flag was observed. The group then walked back to their vehicles retracing their steps more or less. This portion of the site walk ended at 9:24 AM and the group disbanded.

The site walk for the Sand Dam Road crossing of the Five Mile River began at 9:37 AM. The purpose of this portion of the site walk was to view site conditions associated with the replacement of the Sand Dam Road bridge over the Five Mile River with a culvert and work associated with raising the grade of the road for approaches to the culvert. In attendance were Commissioner H. Charles Obert and myself. The site was reviewed. This portion of the site walk ended at 10:15 AM.
