 - b. Cathy Thomas moved and Cynthia Antos seconded the motion to publicize the additional fees. The motion carried.
 - c. Stephen Bordua moved and Cathy Thomas seconded the motion to invite the Board

of Education and the Board of Selection to a discussion. The motion carried.
