BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Meeting of the Town of Thompson that the resolutions dated January 29, 1970 and revision dated September 30, 1976 is hereby amended and restated as follows:

RESOLVED The Thompson Recreational Commission shall consist of Seven (7) members to be appointed by the Board of Selectmen for terms of three (3) years commencing April 15. The terms of the members shall be arranged so that no more than one-third of the member terms shall expire in any one (1) year. The Board of Selectmen shall also make any appointments necessary to fill vacancies occurring on the Commission from time to time. The membership shall be arranged so that minority representation shall be in compliance with Connecticut General Statutes, Revision of 1958, revised to January 2007, Title 9, Elections Section 9-167(a). Such members shall be sworn and serve until their successors have been appointed and have qualified and shall receive no compensation for their services. The Selectmen shall be ex-officio members of such Commission.

The Recreational Commission shall study and plan the development of recreational facilities for the Town and make recommendations, from time to time, to the legislative body of the Town in respect to the development of the Town's parks and recreation programs. Said commission shall have the supervision and management of all the public playgrounds, swimming pools, gymnasiums, creation places, athletic fields, and equipment and facilities connected therewith as are or may be hereafter established.
