- Air Line Trail: Requests for DPW help: (in addition to completing stone dust to state line) to use over-the-fence mower to keep brush down along sides of Air Line Trail to move rocks a few feet in at SandDam Rd. parking to allow 2 cars to park face in without sticking out into road
  - paint pedestrian crosswalks at trail crossings on East Thompson Road and at Sanddam Rd. and install "Trail Crossings" signs
