Trail updates:

• Great East Thompson Train Wreck park project: J&D Engineering readjusting the boundary survey with the Butlers for turntable site. Tyra reported some of the reimbursements from the previous grant should be coming in and we should hear about the next round of grants May/June.

• John plans to take care of damaged bridge railing on ALSPT and someone on Facebook reported trees down between condos and Sunset Hill

- 12-Town ALSPT Task Force has hired a replacement for Jeanne Davies.
- trail around Bull Hill soccer field needs assessment & clean-up of downed branches

• Michael St Lawrence expects 6-9 months before there is a grant decision on funding purchase of the 272 acres of Boy Scout land adjacent to the 75 LeClair Preserve acres. WLT would like a partnership with Trails to plan and implement a trail system once the land is acquired.

- installation of HETAP assessment signs on ALSPT (contact Matt Quinn)

- Thompson trail signage (in coordination with either 12-Town Task Force or independently if necessary)
- continue TLGV trail assessments behind Drafters (coordinate with new developer; extend or loop trail?)

- Tyra reported that Thompson submitted their funds for reprints of Z-fold maps
- · John needs material to post on social media

• coordinate with Historical Society & Conservation Commission if any trails data should be included in their plan for self-guided cemetery tour
