• John mowed ALSPT from Mass line to Sunset Hill

• The ALSPT Master Plan developed by the 12-Town Task is completed. CTDEEP grant awarded to establish ongoing Board to implement plan, which will be meeting in the fall. Plan available at

• Thompson awarded CTDEEP grant of \$457,000 to continue Great East Thompson Train Wreck park project. Next step: J&D Engineering adding some details to the boundary survey requested by Town attorney before review by Butlers' attorney for turntable site. Suggestion to think about an official name for the site, maybe hold a naming contest.

• Brian suggested we prioritize Trails monies for stonedust before other trail amenities. Bike repair station is still pending EDC contribution to funding.

• Karen will contact CTDEEP again about installation of TLGV assessment signs.

• Michael St Lawrence reported WLT awarded CTDEEP grant to fund parking lot at Bull Hill and expecting work to be completed before next winter. JDEngineering has begun survey work.

Reports from neighboring towns

• Putnam's ALSPT plan was only partially funded by CTDEEP and their public meeting has been postponed
